### GETTING STARTED

The aim of Othello is to have the most disks of your colour face up on the board at the end of the game. If you are playing BLACK you need more black disks showing than white disks, to win.

Trap and capture your opponent by placing your disks on the board. "Sandwich" at least one of your opponent's pieces to turn their disk to your colour.

Here's an example: White disk A was already in place on the board. The placement of white disk B sandwiched the row of 3 black disks.



White flips the sandwiched disks and the row now looks like this.

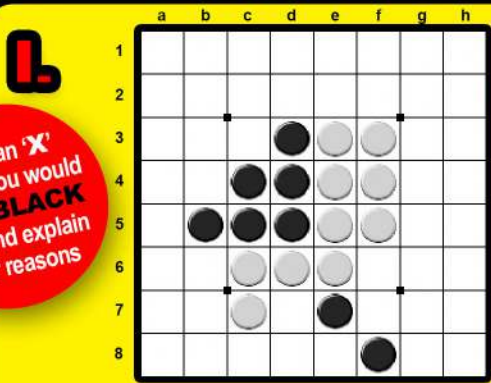


A disk may "sandwich" any number of disks in one or more rows in any number of directions at the same time – horizontally, vertically or diagonally.

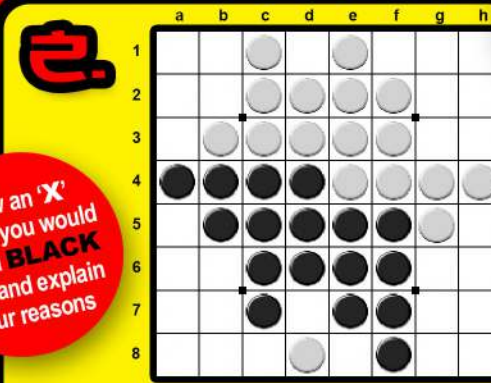

- The people selected will be contacted by email or by post, with further details about the Cambridge final.
- Only those that attend the Cambridge final and compete will be eligible to claim their board game bundle complementary prize (worth to the value of £100).
- John Adams Leisure Ltd accepts no responsibility for entries that are lost, delayed, damaged, misdirected or incomplete or cannot be delivered or entered for any technical or other reason. Proof of delivery of the entry is not proof of receipt by John Adams Leisure Ltd.

#### Specific terms for the British Othello Junior Championship Winner

- To enter the British Othello Junior Championship, you must be a UK resident and must be born between 01/01/2005 and 01/01/2011 at the time of entry. Proof of identity and age may be required and John Adams Leisure Ltd reserves the right to verify the eligibility of all entrants.
- The winner will be notified on the day of the Cambridge final, where if they have won, they will be crowned the British Othello Junior Champion and will go on to compete at the World Othello Championship in Hong Kong on October (8th-11).
- The winner must be available to travel between the 7th October to the 12th October 2019 with parental and school permission.
- Entrants must have permission from their parents or guardian to enter and have sought permission from their school and teacher to have time off to attend the World Othello Championships.
- One winner will receive flights to Hong Kong, transfers, accommodation and meals for themselves and one parent or guardian, with the condition that the competition winner will compete at the World Othello Championship in October in Hong Kong to represent the UK. The total value for meals will be capped at £400.
- The adjudicator's decision is final and is not up for dispute.
- If the winner is not available to travel to Hong Kong, then the next runner up will take their place.
- The prize is subject to availability, non-transferable, non-exchangeable and there is no cash alternative.
