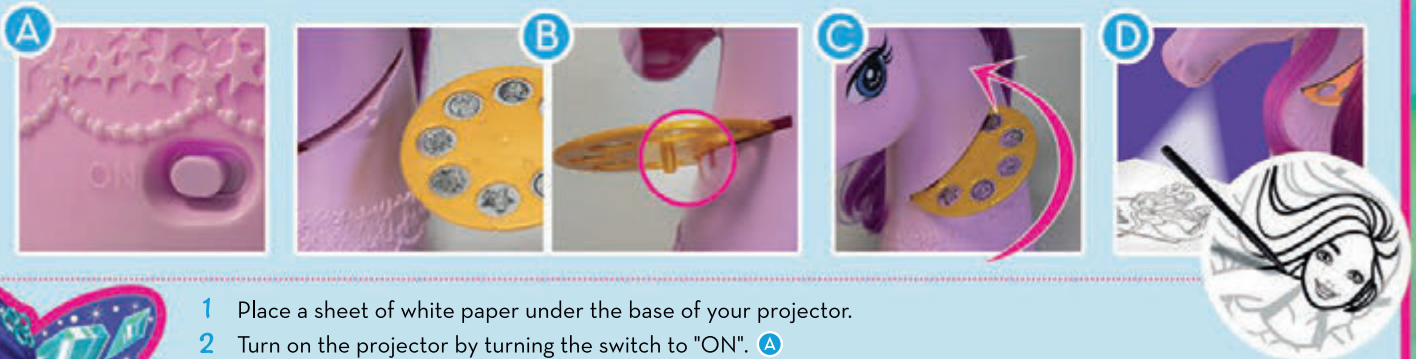



- 1 Unscrew the protective cover under the toy.
- 2 Unscrew the battery compartment. Insert three new AA/LR6 batteries (1.5 V), preferably alkalines, making sure to observe polarity (+, -). 
- 3 Firmly re-tighten the compartment cover.
- 4 Insert the horn into the hole between the ears of the unicorn projector. 



YOUR 2-IN-1 PROJECTOR IS NOW READY!

INSTALLING
AND REPLACING BATTERIES



- 1 Place a sheet of white paper under the base of your projector.
- 2 Turn on the projector by turning the switch to "ON". 
- 3 Insert one of the two discs into the slot until it stops. Make sure that the disc is inserted on the right side: the spike must be downwards. 
- 4 You have 16 images to choose from! Choose the design you want to project by rotating the disc. 
- 5 Use the black marker to trace the image that appears on the paper.
- 6 When you have finished your drawing, turn your projector off by turning the switch to "OFF". 
- 7 Style your unicorn's hair with the included comb!

- Batteries should be replaced by an adult.
- Do not attempt to power battery products from the mains supply and do not insert connecting wires into electrical socket outlets.
